



Witnessing To A The Jehovah Witness

1. When a Jehovah Witness comes to talk to you about their God Jehovah you can take them through this scriptural exercise to show them that Christ is the only way to life. They do believe in God but not in Christ the Savior.

If they have their Bible with them, have them look up these following passages. Each passage ask them who it is referring to and they will tell you Jehovah (God). This holds true till they get to Rev 2:8. For their Jehovah is not dead. If that was the case why does their Bible state that? That is because it is talking about Jesus Christ. Don't be surprised if they don't have an answer for you.

Note: Passages come from the KJV.

- a. Isaiah 41:4 Who hath wrought and done it, calling the generations from the beginning? I the LORD, the first, and with the last; I am he.
 - b. Isaiah 44:6 Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.
 - c. Isaiah 48:12 Hearken unto me, O Jacob and Israel, my called; I am he; I am the first, I also am the last.
 - d. Rev 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.
 - e. Rev 2:8 And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; These things saith the first and the last, **which was dead**, and is alive;
 - f. Rev 22:13 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.
2. Another belief they have is that they are part of the 144,000 that the Bible mentions. There is a question you can ask them before you read the passage to them.
 - a. Are you married and do you have kids? Then you are not a virgin.
 - b. Are you Jewish and what tribe do you come from? If not Jewish you aren't in that number.
 - c. Have you had sex out of marriage? Then you are not a virgin?
 - i. Rev 7:2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,
 - ii. Rev 7:3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.
 - iii. Rev 7:4 **And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.**
 - iv. Rev 7:5 Of the **tribe of Juda** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Reuben** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Gad** were sealed twelve thousand.
 - v. Rev 7:6 Of the **tribe of Aser** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Nephthalim** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Manasses** were sealed twelve thousand.
 - vi. Rev 7:7 Of the **tribe of Simeon** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Levi** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Issachar** were sealed twelve thousand.
 - vii. Rev 7:8 Of the **tribe of Zabulon** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Joseph** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Benjamin** were sealed twelve thousand.
 - viii. Rev 14:1 And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads.
 - ix. Rev 14:2 And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps:

- x. Rev 14:3 And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth.
 - xi. Rev 14:4 ***These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins.*** These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb.
 - xii. Rev 14:5 And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God.
 - xiii. Rev 14:6 And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,
 - xiv. Rev 14:7 Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.
3. Why do some Kingdom Halls have no windows and what is their belief on the Trinity?
- a. I always wonder this as I go past some of there buildings. Here is a response I got off the Internet from a JW attendee.
 - b. ***It depends on the neighborhood. Because people like to threw things to break the windows. Also it is cheaper to built them without windows. There are many Kingdom Halls that have windows. The Kingdom Hall that I go to has windows. We are not hiding anything. Everyone is welcome to come inside. Also we are not a cult. We worship Jehovah God. People call us a cult because we don't believe in the trinity and because we don't celebrate holidays. We still have more fun. We have parties during the year. We have weddings, baby showers and get together parties.***
 - c. As you can see there is no belief of the trinity in JW, which the Bible is very clear, exists. Although the Bible does not use the word Trinity it does state that Jesus and God are one and that the comforter who is known as the Holy Spirit works to bring us to Christ.
 - i. John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him.
 - ii. We can see that the Father is first, the Son is second, and the Holy Spirit is third. The Father is not begotten, but the Son is (John 3:16). The Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father (John 5:26). The Father sent the Son (1 John 4:10). The Son and the Father send the Holy Spirit (John 14:26; 15:26). The Father creates (Isaiah 44:24), the Son redeems (Gal. 3:13), and the Holy Spirit sanctifies (Rom. 15:16).
4. Summary
- a. You don't have to feel intimidated when a JW approaches you. You need to remember that they have a soul and we need for them to see the light of salvation. Don't be arrogant when witnessing to them. Leave them a seed for them to ponder on.
 - b. Tell them to pray first and to search the scriptures themselves and ask God to show them the truth.
 - c. A great place to tell them to start in the scriptures is the book of John.
