



## Bible Version Comparison

### Instruction:

It gains you nothing to argue with an individual with mere words or thoughts regarding the Bible. Anytime we are conversing with someone we need to have the Bible with us. The bible states that the word of the Lord does not come back void (*Isa 55:11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper [in the thing] whereto I sent it. (kjv)*). When discussing the subject of Bible versions, it is best to get the various Bible versions out and read the scripture passages and see how they line up with each other to that of the KJV.

Remember to pray first before getting into this discussion asking the spirit to give wisdom and discernment. If the person becomes argumentative, don't lose your cool, just keep pointing to the scripture if this still does not work, close down the conversation. Remember in Mark 4 a seed has been planted and let God take care of the rest.

### Satan is always attacking the words of the Bible

From the beginning in Genesis 3 the devil deceived Eve in the Garden by twisting the words of God. Satan even tried it on Jesus Christ in Matthew 4 when he tempted him during the 40 days in the wilderness. However Satan did not trick Christ, because Christ combated him with the true word of God.

### Not A War of Flesh and Blood

Eph 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places]. (kjv)

In Ephesians 6 it describes the Armor of God. The only defensive weapon we have is the Spirit of the Sword which is the word of God. If the devil can change wording around or eliminate them, our power is diminished. He is taking away the sword and replacing on our hands a pocketknife to defend ourselves.

### Basic Biblical Principles:

### NIV Stats:

There are two individuals that participated on the committee that helped publish the NIV translation. They are Dr. Marten Woodstra and Virginia Mollenkott.

Dr. Woodstra replaced words in the bible that mentioned sodomites and replaced them with shrined prostitutes. You will find when you research this person that he was actively involved with associations that promoted homosexuality.

Omitted Blood 23 times- NIV version 41 times.

Omitted Hell 22 times and substituted the word with Hades which some rock songs indicate that Hades a place they are going to party.

Others that have been omitted are Repent, Damned, Damnation, Devils (changed to Demons – which Webster Dictionary calls a divinity) and substituted Lord with sir or master.

### The Use of Symbols

The Bible makes it perfectly clear that we should not make idols or worship them. It states in Acts 17:29 that we should not make any image regarding the trinity, art work or symbol.

*Acts 17:29 Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device.(kjv)*

It may come to a shock to some that on the NKJV Bible a symbol was placed on the cover. This symbol is supposed to represent the Trinity. That is what we are told to believe. If you investigate it further, this symbol has its roots from witchcraft and satan worship. There are even some rock groups who confess they are devil worshipers to have placed this symbol on their song covers. What did the word of God state regarding symbols of the Trinity? There have been some in the world that have been deceived to tattoo the symbol on them.

## Bible Version Comparison

### Summary

Some of us live under the assumption that everyone has been raised in a Christian environment. We feel that everyone knows what the Bible means. What we forget is that when you do take a survey of the landscape, most individuals do not know very much of the Bible and how its complete words are important to us.

The newer translations replaced words such as Lord and God with he and him. When a true Christian reads these words, we somehow can piece it together and have knowledge of what it means. But for the person who has not background he and him is confusing and in the end days, it will be revealed that the antichrist will assume the role of those names.

In Isaiah 14 you will see that the KJV mentions Lucifer, but the NIV version replaces his name with Morning star.

*Isaiah 14:12-15 How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! [how] art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit. (kjb)*

*Isaiah 14:12-15 How you have fallen from heaven, O morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth, you who once laid low the nations! You said in your heart, "I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God; I will sit enthroned on the mount of assembly, on the utmost heights of the sacred mountain. I will ascend above the tops of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High." But you are brought down to the grave, to the depths of the pit. (NIV)*

Why is Morning Star so critical of a word to watch? Well it has caused some confusion with those who are getting into the faith and buying the new revised standard Bibles. Some believe that Jesus Christ is satan because of Revelation 22:16.

*Revelation 22:16 "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star." (kjb)*

*Revelation 22:16 "I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you\* this testimony for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the bright Morning Star." (NIV)*

We know the true Morning Star is Christ and the Devil has through history tried to take on that role. That is why it is important not to become deceived and always search out a matter in Gods word, get Godly counsel and pray for discernment.
