The family who had been providing the food those Thursdays has asked us to take over while the wife has her baby and rest before coming back. By taking on that aspect of providing food it will be an additional investment of approx \$125.00. In total we are committing to City View on a Monthly basis approx \$200.00 to help the less fortunate. Please consider donating to the WAHU fund to keep this ministry operating.

We had so many helpers that the less fortunate were told to stay seated and we would bring the food to them. They loved it, and enjoyed being served. There were also young people who sat down with the people and kids and had a great time conversing with them.


