



Directions to Sheltowee Trace Outfitters

(Note: Big South Fork and Russell Fork trips meet at a remote location)

From I-75 Southbound: Take Exit 25 (Corbin). Turn right at the off-ramp onto 25W, southbound. Follow the signs for Cumberland Falls State Resort Park. This will involve staying on 25W for 8 miles, and then bearing right onto Hwy 90 west. Follow this for about 2 miles. You should see a sign that says Cumberland Falls State Resort Park, 5 miles. We are just past this sign on the left hand side. If you enter the Daniel Boone National Forest, you have gone about ½ mile too far.

From I-75 Northbound: Take Exit 15 (Williamsburg). Turn left at the off-ramp on 25W northbound. Follow the signs for Cumberland Falls State Resort Park. This will involve staying on 25W for 5 miles, and then turning left (more of a fork) onto Hwy 90 west. Follow this for about 2 miles. You should see a sign that says Cumberland Falls State Resort Park, 5 miles. We are just past this sign on the left hand side. If you enter the Daniel Boone National Forest, you have gone about ½ mile too far.

From US 27 Southbound: Turn left onto Hwy 90 east at Parker's Lake. This is approximately 30 minutes south of Somerset. *Note that Hwy 90 west turns right off of US 27 in Burnside (5-10 minutes south of Somerset). You DO NOT want to turn there.* Follow Hwy 90 for 12 miles. You will cross over the Cumberland River and enter the Cumberland Falls State Resort Park. Stay on the main road (Hwy 90) as you go through the park and continue another 5 miles past the park. We are on the right hand side, approximately ½ miles after you leave the Daniel Boone National Forest.

From US 27 Northbound: Turn right onto Hwy 1045, approximately 4 mile north of Whitley City. If you miss this turn, you can turn right onto Hwy 90 3 mile further on, and follow the directions in US 27 Southbound above. In approximately 8 miles, Hwy 1045 will 'T' onto Hwy 90. Turn right onto Hwy 90. In miles, you will cross over the Cumberland River and enter the Cumberland Falls State Resort Park. Stay on the main road (Hwy 90) as you go through the park and continue another 5 miles past the park. We are on the right hand side, approximately ½ miles after you leave the Daniel Boone National Forest.

Caution: Highways 25, 25W, and 25E are 3 different roads in this area. Taking 25 or 25E west is not the same as taking 25W.
